### JOB PURPOSE:

The Dispensing Audiologist provides direct clinical services to Audiology patients of all ages at both clinic locations. Specialization in Pediatric Audiology is preferable but not required. The Dispensing Audiologist reports to the Audiology Director. At CEID, an audiologist will be a part of a small, but effective team, and will have positive opportunities to be part of a learning environment!

### JOB RESPONSIBILITIES:

The Dispensing Audiologist performs evaluations, screenings and hearing aid dispensing in alignment with professional standards of practice.

### JOB DUTIES:

- Provide accurate and appropriate testing and evaluations, diagnosis, referrals and active follow-up of all patients.
- Provide hearing aid/assistive device evaluation, fitting, programming, verification based on current industry standards.
- Offer patient and family training in accordance with best practices for identification and

- intervention of newly identified hearing loss as well as new hearing aid technologies.
- Provide knowledge to recommend new program development based on innovative technology/techniques as appropriate.
  - Have knowledge of, and provide services in compliance with the policies and procedures of the Audiology Program and CEID's record keeping, clinical goals and protocols, patient eligibility, patient scheduling, patient discharge, and all quality assurance standards maintained by CEID, MediCal, CCS and all outside control and contracting agencies.
  - Participate as a team member with other audiology staff in meetings and agency-wide staff development meetings
  - Assist and participate with planning of patient education, outreach and/or center promotional events.
  - Other duties as assigned
